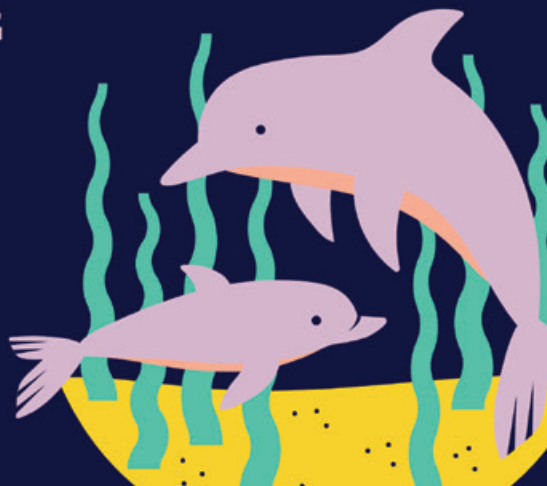

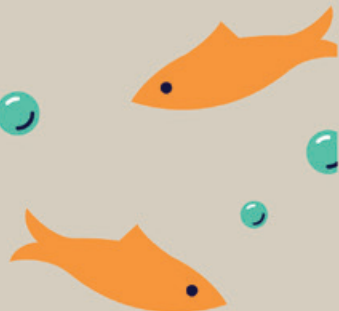

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION



WATER SAFETY

- We strongly recommend everyone wears a lifejacket when on the pontoons or afloat & this is mandatory for those under 18.
- Anyone entering the water or going afloat as part of Portland Week must be able to swim at least 50m in light clothing.
- We will have marshals and safety officers available during water based activities, but our staff & volunteers are not lifeguards.
- Please also remember that, even at this time of year, the water is cold and wear appropriate clothing accordingly!
- If you see someone in trouble, alert a member of the event team & locate the nearest SOS bollard & safety ladder or safe exit from the water.

FIRE SAFETY

- If you hear the fire alarm, please make your way to the fire muster point & follow instructions from our staff & volunteers
- The muster point is on the hard standing area near the Lynx helicopter

CHILD SAFETY

- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times unless otherwise stated.
- If your child is lost, please go to the event marquee

FIRST AID

- All marina staff are first aid trained
- First aid kits are located in the marina office, event marquee, boatcare office, marina work boat and in the SOS bollards on the pontoons.

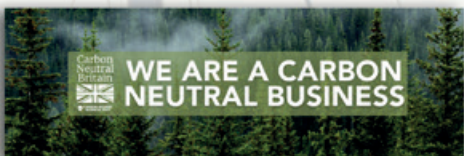

Parking Technology Helps Protect Marine Life

Premier Park's client boatfolk has been working tirelessly to protect Studland Bay's seagrass meadows and seahorses. Boatfolk's work with The Seahorse Trust, both founding members of The Studland Bay Marine Partnership, has resulted in the deployment of new eco-friendly moorings that reduce damage to the ecosystem caused by traditional mooring techniques.

The traditional method of mooring involves dragging a heavy chain across the seabed, damaging the ecosystem. In contrast, the eco-moorings use a lightweight rope and a helix anchor that twists into the seabed, reducing damage. The new eco-moorings also provide boaters with the opportunity to pay for their duration of stay and donate to The Seahorse Trust using technology developed by Agena. We have been able to provide a digital payment and donation processing solution, with 100% of the mooring fee going to the charity.

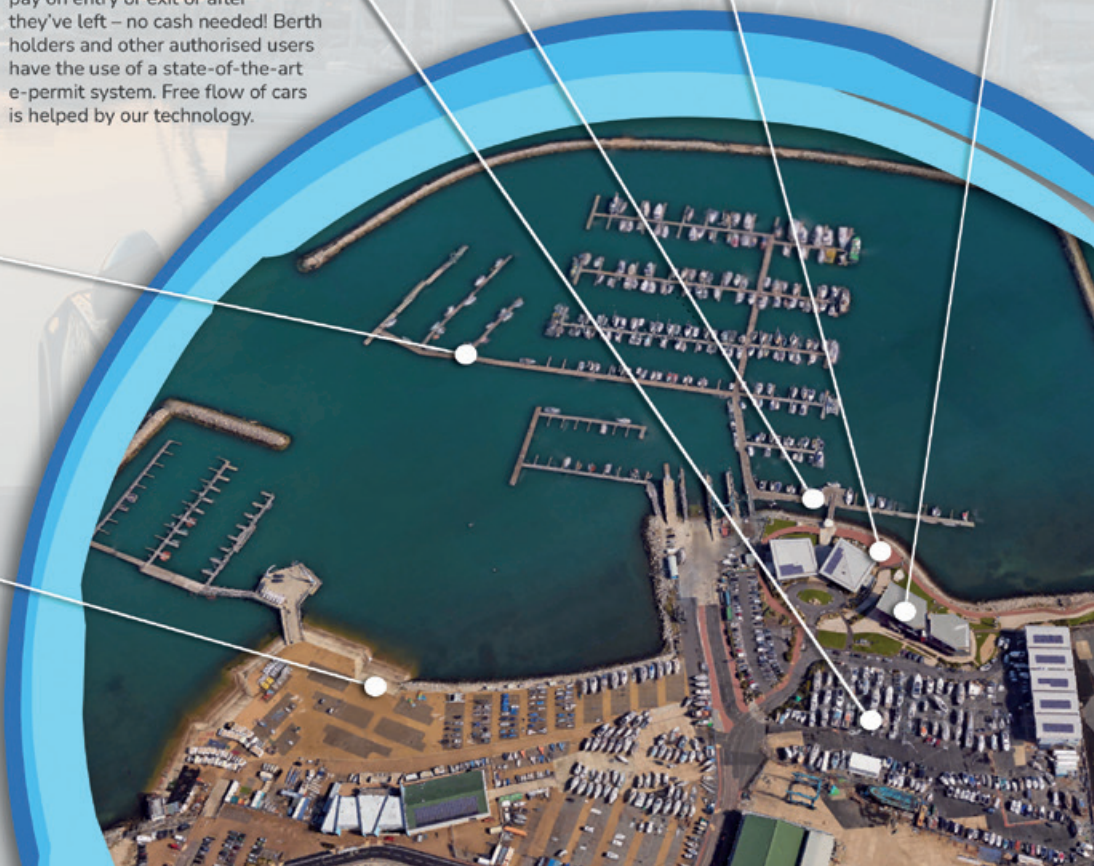

Portland Marina are extremely excited to announce a new partnership with our long-standing marina charity, Clean Jurassic Coast CIC (CJC), and marathon swimmer Chloë McCardel's Channel Queen charter business to deliver marine and conservation educational programs to young people onboard Chloë's swim support vessel, Channel Queen, berthed here with us at Portland.

The educational sessions will be a mixture of classroom based activities on Channel Queen and interactive activities such as beach cleaning, exploring and learning about the effect of plastic waste found on our beaches and in the sea, and what can be done to minimise this impact through sustainable living. Sessions will also include learning about the rich geological and fossil history of the area as well as the unique geographical and marine environment of the Jurassic Coast. The outdoor sessions will be based at beaches near Portland Marina, such as Chesil Cove.

Clean Jurassic Coast was founded in 2020 by Roy Beal, bringing individual beach cleaners together to expand their reach and create an element of fun and social interaction whilst doing good things for the environment. As a keen kayaker, Roy accessed harder to reach areas by sea, pulling huge amounts of debris and rubbish from the nooks and crannies of the Jurassic Coast, but he was limited by the amount he could carry out on his kayak.



With support from several friends taking on some amazing challenges to raise funds, Roy purchased a folding RIB to access the harder to reach areas in 2021, kitted out with an outboard engine provided by boatcare through fundraising by the marina team, thus commencing the collaboration between CJC and Portland Marina. At the same time as the partnership between Portland Marina and Clean Jurassic Coast was taking root, Chloë McCardel was completing the swim which would see her crowned 'Queen of the English Channel' by the Channel Swimming Association in 2021. This official title was bestowed on her following her World Record 44th solo crossing of the English Channel.



Chloë purchased Channel Queen in 2022 with the aim of providing inclusive and welcoming events to swimmers looking for an open water experience with full support along the southern English coast.

With all three organisations having the same environmental concerns and ethos, it was a no-brainer to collaborate to create an educational and inspirational program for young people in Dorset!

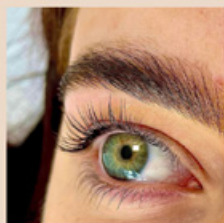

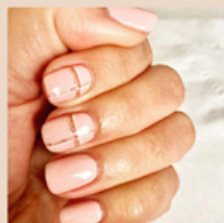

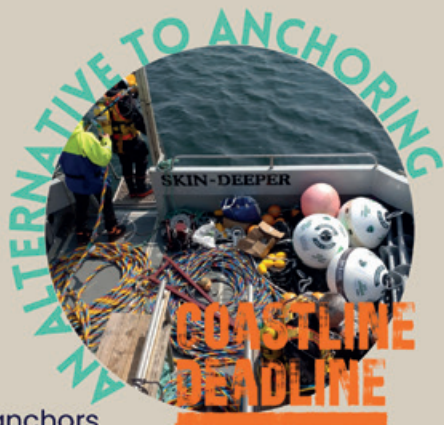
ECO MOORINGS: STUDLAND BAY MARINE PARTNERSHIP

Studland Bay is a popular destination for boaters, however the dropping of anchors has damaging consequences for both the seabed and the creatures which call it their home. That's why boatfolk joined forces with the charity The Seahorse Trust back in 2021 to install 10 eco-moorings at the site. The project has been a resounding success leading to the creation of the Studland Bay Marine Partnership (SBMP) and fundraising for a further 21 moorings which were installed this spring.

Studland Bay became a designated Marine Conservation Zone in 2018 due to Studland's rare seagrass meadows. Seagrass can store up to twice as much carbon per hectare as terrestrial forests, supporting the reduction of climate change. In addition to this Studland's seagrass meadows are an internationally important breeding ground for the protected Spiny Seahorse, one of Britain's native seahorse species. The Spiny Seahorse was protected in 2008 under the Wildlife and Countryside Act following campaigning by the Seahorse Trust.

The benefits of eco-moorings are well-documented. They involve a helical screw anchor being driven into the seabed with an elastic rode attached, connecting the anchor system with the mooring buoy. The elastic rode stretches at higher tides and contracts at lower tides, avoiding the scouring of the seabed which traditional mooring set-ups and anchors cause.

The project has been widely supported by the boating community and the SBMP says it will continue its fundraising efforts, with the intention of installing a further 57 eco-moorings by 2024.

ELLA HIBBERT: SOLO ARCTIC EXPEDITION

Ella Hibbert is a 26 year old RYA Yachtmaster Instructor who, during the summer of 2024, will attempt to become the first person to complete a solo circumnavigation of the Arctic Circle, a feat which should not be possible...



The voyage intends to raise awareness about the effects of global warming and climate change on one of our planets' most fragile regions. Ella has purchased a 38ft Bruce Robert's designed steel ketch, called Yeva, specifically for the circumnavigation. The boat is currently berthed in Haslar Marina, courtesy of boatfolk, who were Ella's very first sponsors. Since starting the campaign last summer, she has secured sponsorships from a variety of generous companies who share her passion for conservation and eco-conscious boating, and is currently undertaking Yeva's interior refit herself whilst trying to secure the financial backing needed to complete external works to the hull, replace the engine and prepare the yacht for the harsh conditions she will face in the Arctic regions.

Ella will be auctioning Yeva at the end of the voyage and donating all proceeds to the expedition's charities, Polar Bears International and Ocean Conservancy.

James Harayda, the team principal and skipper of the Gentoo Sailing Team, is a passionate sailor and an ambassador for boatfolk's #BoatGen campaign.

James' love for sailing started early in life, and he has honed his skills to become a formidable force in the sport. Currently he is the youngest skipper competing in the IMOCA Globe Series and, In November 2024, the gun will sound for the 10th edition of the Vendée Globe with James and 'Gentoo' on the start line, embarking on one of the toughest challenges available to mankind. He will race around the world, non-stop, by himself, and completely unassisted. The race will last around 80 days, most of which are spent in some of the most remote, extreme, and hostile environments of the world.

James is dedicated to promoting inclusivity and accessibility in sailing through his involvement as a #BoatGen ambassador and Gentoo Sailing team's youth development program. He actively works to break down barriers and inspire a new generation of sailors from diverse backgrounds. The youth team comprises 12 sailors (6 male, 6 female), aged 16-23. They come from all different backgrounds in sailing and life through a shared passion for the ocean and the sport of sailing.

James will be joining Chloë and Ella for our Talks in the Tent - Inspiring Futures on Thursday 24 August at 7pm.
